Fr. Louis Merosne

Fr. Louis Merosne was born in Haiti and grew up in Boston, MA. After graduating from the Boston Latin School he studied at the Franciscan University of Steubenville for undergraduate and graduate degrees. As a missionary, he helped establish Haiti180 in the south of Haiti. In 2010, he responded to the call to definitively return to his homeland in order to serve the poor and the local church. In 2011, he was ordained a priest in the Diocese of Anse-à-Veau and Miragoâne! Father continues to preach the Gospel and to serve the poor in Haiti and abroad. Currently, he is the pastor of the Cathedral of Saint Anne. He also serves as episcopal vicar on his bishop's council. He is a board member of Life Teen International and other mission oriented organizations. He is the Executive Director of the Francis Integral Development Foundation Corp, a New York registered foundation promoting a Strategic Plan of Integral Human Development of Haiti through a Revival of National Production and Capacity Building. Father Louis is an international speaker who ministers at youth and adult conferences as well as at parish missions. He is passionate about knowing Jesus and making Him known. He loves Mary and the Church. He founded Mission to The Beloved, a US not-for-profit organization with the mission of preaching the Gospel and serving the poor, especially in Haiti.
